Dear Unit Directors,

On behalf of the Golden Triangle Performance Ensemble, we would like to thank you in advance for participating in our event. Included in this packet are the show schedule, school map, and directions to the event.

The event will begin promptly at 5:00. Both Performer & Spectator doors will open at 3:30. However, please note that there will be NO gym access until 4:30.

Only performers & staff/chaperones holding TRWEA passes will be admitted at the Performer entrance. All others MUST enter through the Spectator entrance. You will have 10 passes per unit for staff/chaperones/floor crew. Anyone over that 10 will need to pay an additional fee of \$4.00 per person.

Men's and Women's locker room facilities are available for performer use. As these areas are readily available, performer preparation (clothes changing, use of hairspray, etc.) will not be permitted in the public restrooms or any other common areas. Additionally, it is strongly recommended that a chaperone from your unit be present in the locker room with your students. Due to the large number of participants in this year's show, we request that your unit be generous in sharing these facilities with other students. Following your performance, please vacate the locker room, in order to make space for units that arrive for later performance times. Finally, please note that neither the Golden Triangles, East Allegheny School District, nor TRWEA will be held responsible for lost or stolen property.

A map has been included in this packet. Please familiarize yourself, staff, students, & chaperones with the school layout. We will do our best to have guides stationed throughout the building for the duration of the event.

Note that again this year, we will have body AND equipment warmup areas. For those of you that have attended our show in previous years, the body warmup will be held in the hallway directly adjacent to the cafeteria (equipment warmup area).

Floors will open from the back of the gymnasium to the front.

Equipment may only be used in the warm-up and performance areas. For the safety of patrons and performers alike, as well as to preserve school property, this rule will be strictly enforced. You may warm-up outside (away from heavily populated spectator areas) at your discretion. Note that this does not include the covered deck area at unit check-in.

Buses & trucks must park in the upper lot of Logan Middle School.

Due to space limitations, we request that all props and equipment be removed immediately following your unit's performance. These items will not be permitted to return to the equipment area.

As the equipment holding area is directly across & in close proximity to the gymnasium, your unit's floor & props will not be permitted to be brought into the hallway until the unit prior to you has entered the gymnasium. Please instruct your prop crew to refrain from entering this area until the proper time. For safety reasons, we cannot have this area “clogged” with unnecessary people & equipment.

There are no longer bleachers in the back of the gymnasium. Therefore, performer seating will be in the upper level of the front side.

The Golden Triangle Senior ensemble performs @ 8:14. Critique will begin immediately following in the teachers' lounge (adjacent to cafeteria).
