Dear Unit Directors,

On behalf of the Golden Triangle Performance Ensemble, we would like to thank you in advance for participating in our event. Included in this packet are the show schedule, school map, and directions to the event.

The event will begin promptly at 6:00. Both Performer & Spectator doors will open at 4:30. However, please note that there will be NO gym access until 5:30.

PLEASE NOTE: Everyone is required to pass through a metal detector at East Allegheny. The metal detectors are located at spectator entrance. Therefore, we are asking that all units send a couple of representatives to unit entrance to drop off equipment and collect their wristbands. Once you have passed out the wristbands to your members, staff etc., you will need to proceed to spectator entrance to pass through the metal detectors. Golden Triangle dads will take your equipment from unit entrance and place it in the equipment area for you to retrieve once you have passed through the detectors. This will avoid having the pass equipment through the detectors.

Men's and Women's locker room facilities are available for performer use. As these areas are readily available, performer preparation (clothes changing, use of hairspray, etc.) will not be permitted in the public restrooms or any other common areas. Additionally, it is strongly recommended that a chaperone from your unit be present in the locker room with your students. Due to the large number of participants in this year's show, we request that your unit be generous in sharing these facilities with other students. Following your performance, please vacate the locker room, in order to make space for units that arrive for later performance times. Finally, please note that neither the Golden Triangles, East Allegheny School District, nor TRWEA will be held responsible for lost or stolen property.

Performers, patrons, and staff are strictly prohibited from entering non-public areas. Security will be onsite and there are cameras in the restricted areas. Note that refusal to adhere to this WILL lead to immediate removal from school premises and may also include police dispatch.

A map has been included in this packet. Please familiarize yourself, staff, students, & chaperones with the school layout. We will do our best to have guides stationed throughout the building for the duration of the event.

Note that again this year, we will have body AND equipment warmup areas. For those of you that have attended our show in previous years, the body warmup will be held in the hallway directly adjacent to the cafeteria (equipment warmup area). In equipment warmup, please be cognizant of the ceiling & ensure that it is not being hit.

Floors will open from the back of the gymnasium to the front.

Buses & trucks must park in the upper lot of Logan Middle School.

Due to space limitations, we request that all props and equipment be removed immediately following your unit's performance. These items will not be permitted to return to the equipment area.

As the equipment holding area is directly across & in close proximity to the gymnasium, your unit's floor & props will not be permitted to be brought into the hallway until the unit prior to you has entered the gymnasium. Please instruct your prop crew to refrain from entering this area until the proper time. For safety reasons, we cannot have this area “clogged” with unnecessary people & equipment.

Performer seating is ONLY permitted in the balcony of the gymnasium.

Critique will begin immediately following the performance of the Golden Triangle Senior Ensemble. Critique will be held in the teachers' lounge (adjacent to cafeteria).
